

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-9

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BOROUGH CODE OF NORTHUMBERLAND BOROUGH, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO ADD STOP SIGNS FOR THE SAFETY OF THE WALKING AND DRIVING PUBLIC AND SETTING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

SECTION 1. The Borough council finds that the safety and well being of the public is promoted by safe traffic conditions within the Borough of Northumberland, including the coming to a full stop of vehicles at intersections where visibility, congestion, or other conditions create a risk of collision.

SECTION 2. The Borough council determines that stop signs shall be established at the following intersections:

- Sixth Street and Hanover Street [four-way stop]
- Wheatley and Church Avenues [four-way stop]
- Strawbridge Road and Prince Street [three-way stop]
Right turn onto Strawbridge Road from Prince Street still permitted.
- Right turn ONLY at stop sign on west side of Queen Street at Water Street
East bound traffic on Queen Street may only turn right to travel south on Route 11.

All persons shall come to a complete stop at these intersections.

SECTION 3. Any person who violates this Ordinance commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, pay a fine as set forth in the Borough Schedule of Fees and Fines.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective in thirty days.
