AN ORDINANCE

An ordinance re-establishing the Grades of the streets of the Borough of Northumberland, Pennsylvania.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of Northumberland in authority of the same, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the vertisement of this ordinance the grades of the several streets of the said Borough of Northumberland shall be as laid down in the "Grade Book" of the Borough of Northumberland, Pa. "Made by Walter S. Hine, Civil Engineer and Borough Regulator, during the year 1911, under and pursuant to the supervisions and direction of Council, and the grades so fixed are hereby established as the grades of the streets and alleys of the said Borough. The elevations indicating the height above sea level, and are found from a bench mark on the abutment of the Pennsylvania Railroad Bridge over the North Branch of the Susquehanna River at Northumberland 453.48 feet above sea level, made, established and indicated by the United States Government by and through its departmental officers and employees to wit: the Geological Survey, and said grades at the points indicated are as follows:

- 450.59 point east side of Duke Street 146 feet south from Water Street
- 450.67 point West side of Duke Street 100 feet south from Water Street
- 450.82 point four corners intersection of Duke and Water Streets
- 452.18 point East and South corners intersection of Duke St. and Railroad Alley.
- 452.24 point West and North Corners intersection of Duke Street and Railroad Alley.
- 453.98 point four corners intersection of Duke and Front Streets.
- 452.62 point East corner intersection of Duke Street and Park Alley.
- 452.51 point North corner intersection of Duke Street and Park Alley.
- 451.20 point four corners intersection Duke and Second Streets.
- 450.45 point four corners intersection Duke Street and Church Alley.

- 455.25 point culvert on Duke Street between Brickyard Alley & Fifth St.
- 454.65 point four corners intersection of Duke Street and Pond Alley.
- 455.50 point four corners intersection of Duke and Sixth streets.
- 450.73 point East and South corners intersection Duke and Sawmill Alley
- 451.22 point West and North corners intersection Duke St. & Sawmill Alley
- 456.50 point East, South and West Corners intersection Duke and Seventh Streets.
- 469.00 point North corner intersection Duke and Seventh Streets.
- 463.50 point East and West sides of Duke Street 254 feet North of Seventh Street.
- 463.50 point East and West sides of Duke Street 274 feet North of Seventh Street.
- 481.00 point North and East corners intersection Duke and Eighth Sts.
- B: 480.00 point South and West corners intersection Duke and Eighth Sts.
- 450.95 point four corners intersection Queen and Northway Sts.
- 456.47 South and West corners intersection Queen and Water Sts.
- 456.18 point North and East corners intersection Queen and Water Sts.
- 462.14 point East and South corners intersection Queen St. and Depot Alley
- 462.59 point West and North corners intersection Queen Streets And Depot Alley.
- 463.10 point East and West sides of Queen Street 250 feet North of Water Street.
- 463.75 point East and West sides Queen Street 300 ft. North of Water St
- 465.32 point South and West corners intersection Queen and Front Sts.
- 465.63 point North and East corners intersection Queen and Front Sts.
- 466.18 point East and West sides of Queen Street 100 ft. North from Front St.
- 466.23 point East and South corners intersection Queen St. and Park Alley
- 466.10 point West and North corners intersection Queen St. and Park Alley
- 462.86 point East corner intersection Queen and Second Streets.
- 462.34 point North Corner intersection Queen and Second Streets.
- 460.91 point South corner intersection Queen St. and Church Alley.
- 461.01 point East corner intersection Queen St. and Church Alley.
- 462.09 point South and West corners intersection Queen and Second St

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SECTION 2: Grades between points on same side of Street or streets as heretofore designated or as set out in said Grade Book shall be straight.

SECTION 3: The Grade Book shall be placed in the hands of the Town Clerk of Borough regulator and shall be open to the public but under no circumstances shall the Grade book be taken out of the possession of the Town Clerk or Borough Regulator except by order of a majority of the Town Council.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
