

AN ORDINANCE

An ordinance amending an ordinance making Duke Street in the Borough of Northumberland a THRU HIGHWAY and requiring all vehicles entering said street from intersecting streets or alleys to come to a full stop before entering said Duke street by including therein provisions relative to King Street, Water Street and Queen Street in the said Borough of Northumberland.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Northumberland in meeting assembled and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that Section 1 of an ordinance of the Borough of Northumberland enacted and approved the 5th day of March 1928 be amended to read as follows:

"That Duke Street, Queen Street, Water Street and King Street be and the same are hereby declared to be THRU HIGHWAYS in compliance with the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania approved May 11, 1927 and the several amendments and supplements thereto and all vehicles entering said Duke Street, Queen Street, Water Street and King Street from intersecting streets or alleys shall come to a full stop according to the provisions of said Act of Assembly before entering or traveling upon said Duke Street, Queen Street, Water Street, and King Street."

Enacted and ordained into an ordinance this tenth day of July, A. D. 1934.
